Welcome back.

We hope you all had a lovely Easter break and spent time with family and friends. As lockdown rules are beginning to lift slightly, it is lovely to be able to start meeting people outside and spend quality time together. We will continue to follow all safety measures and implement the Department of Education and Public Health guidance.

Staggered drop off and collection times.

Please arrive between your allocated times and avoid arriving early.

- Bubbles- We will continue to operate with four discrete bubbles (Wrens & Bluebell Nursery, Robins, House Martins and Kestrels) The bubbles will not mix at all during the school day.
- **Playtimes** Children will play in their designated areas with children in the same bubble.
- **Lunchtimes** All children will eat in the dining room at staggered times and play outdoors in designated areas with children in their bubbles.
- Packed lunches- Please provide lunch in a disposable bag.
- **Worship** We are hoping to introduce face to face worships and are currently working with Public Health.
- **Book bags** We encourage all children to bring in their book bags to school every day.
- Uniform- Children should come dressed in their school uniform unless it is PE or Outdoor Exploring kit where they will need to come dressed appropriately please.
- Masks- Please continue to wear face masks at all times.
- **Social distancing** Please always keep a 2-metre safe distance.
- **Covid-19 Symptoms** If your child displays symptoms, please do not send them to school. Please book a PCR test as soon as possible.
- Staff continue to do lateral flow tests every Monday and Thursday morning.



Tilston School Association Sunflower Competition

As the weather turns warmer and we start to spend more time outside, the TSA thought it would be nice to encourage all students to roll up their sleeves and turn their hand to some gardening, by taking part in our 2021 Sunflower Competition. Doing a little bit of gardening is not only a great way to maintain a healthy mind, but it can also help the environment, particularly our local bee community, which is crucial for our future.

We are asking students to bring into school on, Friday 30 April £1 in exchange for sunflower seeds that can be planted at home, in pots, in the garden or wherever you see fit. The seeds have been very kindly donated to the school by Limagrain, organised by Horton House Farm, with the £1 proceeds going towards the Tilston School Association.
