Parent Committee Meeting: 23rd March



National Funding Formula and School Budgets

As you are probably aware, there has been a great deal of coverage in the media regarding the new National Funding Formula (NFF) and schools in Cheshire West and Chester, including Tilston, look set to lose considerable amounts of money in future years. The headteachers of the Broxton Federated Group of Schools (BFGS) have written a joint letter to parents to explain the potential impact of the NFF on the cluster.
