#### Can I take my child out of school for a family holiday?

No. Parents are **legally** responsible for ensuring their children receive education in accordance with section 7 of the Education Act 1996 and if on a school roll that they regularly attend school. There is, however, a discretionary power held by Headteachers to authorise absence in exceptional circumstances.

**Please note:** This is not an entitlement and a family holiday is not an exceptional circumstance. Children legally have to be in school from the age of 5 years.

The policy we have in place is in accordance with the primary schools in our cluster. No requests for holidays during term time will be authorised by myself, as Headteacher. In exceptional circumstances I would encourage parents to make an appointment to discuss your circumstances where a decision will be made.
