Car Park

This week we have had contractors visiting the school site to provide quotations for a staff car park and 'drop off' area for parents. The staff currently park on the playground to reduce the traffic congestion on the road, however this reduces the space at playtime and also hinders the teaching of P.E. The quote received is in excess of £30,000 and this does not include a tarmac finish. The work includes: digging out the area and providing a hard standing area to park 15 vehicles. In addition to this work, we would be responsible for the removal of all soil, the application for planning permission and lowering the kerb in order to create an in and out access. If any parents feel they could support us in reducing the cost by offering to help with the grounds work, please let me know. I feel very strongly that our school budget should be used on your child/ren's education and not providing safe parking areas.
