- 1, **APOLOGIES** - Donna, Lucy M & Mrs Mort
- 2, **AGREE MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING** – All agreed
- 3, **WELCOME BREAKFAST DEBRIEF** – Welcome breakfast we have really positive feedback from teachers and parents as it did not impact on the start of the school day. Raised £353.38 profit.
- 4, **AGM MONDAY 23rd OCTOBER 6.30pm** - So far, no e-mail responses to Claire Allwood. We all agreed a WhatsApp message reminder would be advisable to encourage numbers. Kelly is going to contact Belton cheese once we know numbers so we can arrange the cheese.
- 5, **FRIDAY 27th OCT TUCK SHOP** – Helen suggested Hot chocolate cones which she is willing to put together and cost up. We agreed on 30 hot chocolate cones, 100 sweet cones. Kelly A has checked, and we sold the sweet cones at £1.50 last year. For the pocket money stall, we thought glow sticks & reflectors for school bags. LC to order cones & sweets.
- 6, **WEDNESDAY 8th NOVEMBER** – Clothes recycling to school, Kelly is going to create a school poster.
- 7, **8th DECEMBER DISCO** – Key stage 1, 3.15 - 4.15 and Key stage 2, 4.30 - 5.30. Claire suggested hot dogs to be included instead of a biscuit. I have checked the prices from Aldi and a tin of 8 hotdogs is 85p (11p per sausage) and the precut hot dog rolls are 99p for 6 (17p per roll). It would work out 28p per hotdog. Mrs Mort has got a price for the silent disco for 12 headsets £75. Kelly has been able to secure the Christmas gifts (120 selection boxes) kindly donated by Iceland. Trying to work out the best way to promote and sell the tickets this year. We were thinking maybe selling on the yard and a letter home with a reply slip? For the Christmas raffle we thought it might be an idea to ask the class reps to collect prizes for the raffle and create hampers with the prizes. Kirsty is going to organise the printing of the tickets. Draw to take place on the 6th December at the Nativity. Cash prizes, children/adult hampers. Kelly said she will ask Boleworth if they are willing to donate a prize. Nativity bar licence to be sorted by Kirsty. Kelly has got the Santa outfit which she is going to pass on as we have found a willing Santa for the school disco to hand out the gifts at the end.
