<b>Use of PP Funding</b>	<b>Impact</b>
Small group teaching assistant support	<p>Small group TA support helped develop pupils' confidence across a range of year groups and curriculum areas.</p> <p>Teachers lead 'keep up' daily interventions to address misconceptions allowing children to progress through the sequence of lessons in class.</p>
1:1 teaching for Y6 pupils (with an additional teacher)	Targeted support in maths and english
Subsidising residential visits for pupils in Key Stage 2	Small groups of children received financial support for the residential visits in the summer term 2022-2023
Enrichment activities	Pupil premium children access have enrichment activities subsidised using PP grant
Resources including the ELSA programme	<p>Training has continued for staff to implement the ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support) programme to a small groups of pupils. The ELSA programme enables pupils to reflect on themselves and the choices they make, develop a more positive self-image and improve their confidence in order to express their feelings; as a result, pupils are now demonstrating a more positive outlook in school alongside emotional awareness and social skills.</p> <p>The ELSA programme has been a critical tool in supporting children during the pandemic.</p>
Lego Therapy	Lego Therapy is a social development programme for young people with autism spectrum disorders. Resources were purchased and training provided to support



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	groups of pupils with social interaction and communication difficulties. As a result, the resource is being used to support children building friendships and to develop social skills.
Outdoor Exploring	All children from nursery to year 6 take part in a weekly outdoor exploring session. The sessions have been used to provide play based situations where children can reconnect with friends following the pandemic.
