2. NEW MEMBERS WELCOME - Welcome to Lucy and Emily
3. AGREE MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING - 04/06/2024 AGREED - Minutes need uploading to the school website TSA page could do with a bit of an update. Kelly A has said she will have a look over the summer holidays.
4. SUMMER BBQ ROUND UP - Note of thanks to Katie for the cake stall, defiantly worth doing again. BBQ quantity was the correct amount, did not end up with much waste. Iceland have said to Kelly A that they are willing to donate in the future. Kelly A to do a thank you card. Helen Y to organise thank you cards for raffle donations etc. A thank you for Caz and Caroline for sorting out the gazebos and setting them up. Next year we agreed that as the pony rides were a success and if available then will ask if they can do again and put the price up per ride. Claire A confirmed happy to supply the riding hats again if needed. We need to publicise that we can take cash & cards. Target was £2600 and we have made £2154.54 profit so far. We still have refreshments left over which are going to be sold at the end of year production so the profit will go up. Kelly A said that a parent has offered to do cream teas next sports day to sell on the field whilst sports day is on.

Currently need an electrician to complete the work once the trench has been dug up. Need to work out what furniture is needed. Lucy C is going to speak to Poppy in regards to approaching H J Lea Oakes for a donation. We discussed about any potential parents being able to have access to match funding. Hoping to launch the pod Friday 20th September at the welcome breakfast.
