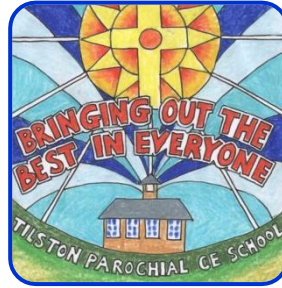

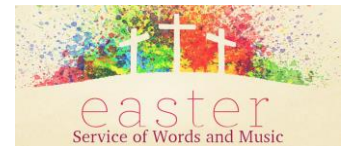
Stars of the Week
