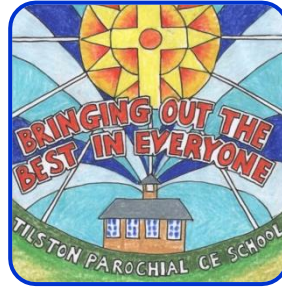

On Sunday 12th May, there will be a joint service at St Edith's in Shocklach for Rogation Sunday with pet blessings at 11:15am. All welcome.

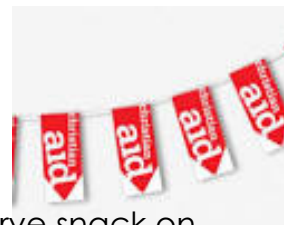


Big Brekkie

As we learn and as we play, may we always be in your safe keeping.

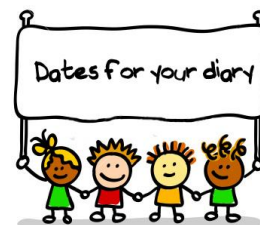
